

Scouting in the Catholic Church

The Roman Catholic Church has used the Scouting program since the early days of the Boy Scouts of America. It is one of the most extensive users of the BSA program.

Religious Emblems. To promote the spiritual phase of Scouting, the Church provides for a religious emblems program. These religious emblems are:

Light of Christ (1st—2nd grades): the purpose of the Light of Christ program is it help your scout develop a personal relationship with Jesus, to see Him as a real person and friend. It helps your scout advance in his spiritual growth and religious knowledge. With your help, he'll complete five topic areas: Families, God's Call, Eucharist, Forgiveness, and Family of God.

Parvuli Dei (3rd—5th grades): the purpose of the emblem is to help scouts explore a wide range of activities to discover the presence of God in their daily lives; to increase awareness of their importance as members of their family, community, and parish; and to develop a positive self-image through the contributions they make. The activities are simple and family-oriented.

Cub Scouts meet in age-specific Den meetings twice a month, with Pack meetings once a month.
